Archaeologist specializing in cultural heritage management. He has graduated from the Department of History and Archeology of the Faculty of Philosophy of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, majoring in Archeology and History of Art. He has a Master's degree in Cultural Management from Panteion University. In 2012 he completed his doctoral thesis in the scientific field of cultural heritage management in the Department of History and Archeology of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. He served as Director of the Chronic Diseases Hospital of Western Athens during 2010-2012. From 2001 to 2015 he was a member of the Research Committee of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and participated in the implementation of many programs in the field of culture. He taught (academic years 2013-2022) in the Thematic Unit "Cultural Policy and Administration" of the "Management of Cultural Units" Master's Program of the Hellenic Open University. In 2022 he republished his book entitled Cultural Heritage Management in Greece, Contemporary Approaches. As of February 2015, he serves as the Head of the Department of Museums and Historical Archives of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens with a series of initiatives and interventions for the protection and promotion of university heritage. He is the scientific editor and author of the book The Management of University Heritage, the Museum of History of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens and has published articles in the field of cultural heritage management. He is a member of the European Association of Archaeologists as well as head of the Civis Museum Network of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens.
