Ilias Papageorgiou is an architect and founder of the PILA office. He has designed and implemented numerous projects of different scales in Europe, America and Asia. Before founding the PILA office, Ilias was head of the SO-IL office in New York. Moreover, he frequently teaches at universities, such as Columbia University of New York, the University of Patras, the University of Thessaly and Tulane University in New Orleans. He is one of the authors of the book *Solid Objectives: Order, Edge, Aura* (Lars Müller Publishers, 2017). His work has been internationally acclaimed and has received awards, such as Curbed Groundbreaker, Architects under 50, Domes International Review of Architecture Awards and the Young Greek Architects Awards. His works have been presented in exhibitions at the Museum of Modern Art and the Cooper Hewitt Museum in New York as well as the Benaki Museum in Athens. He was born in Athens and studied architecture at the Aristotle University in Thessaloniki and at Harvard University in the USA under a scholarship by the Onassis Foundation.
